

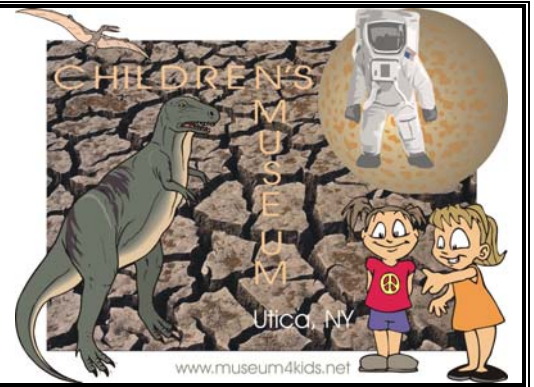
2007 Summer Exhibits & Events at The Children's Museum

Every Day: Space Science - Explore outer space & cool science, w/our interactive scale/timeline/exhibits!

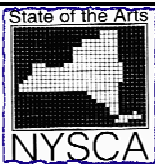
EXHIBITS ON THE FOUR FLOORS OF THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

1st Floor: Playspace for children under 3, Exploration Station for 4 & up; Saturn car, hyperbolic funnel, light/shadow exhibits, funhouse mirrors, microbe room, restrooms w/changing tables, eating/drinking area

2nd Floor: Iroquois Long House w/Kiosks, Local History Dioramas, interactive Musical Stage w/karaoke, Dinosaur *Dinorama*, Paleontology/Fossil center, Erie Canal exhibit, Trading Post, Puppet Theatre

3rd Floor: Living Science Center with animals/insects, Train & Lego activity centers, Hess Truck display, Boats & Bikes, Arts & Crafts, Science Room, Weather Station, Radio Room, Computer Corner, Truck Dig

4th Floor: NASA Lunar Lander / Mars Rover / Columbia Shuttle, Fire & Police exhibits/uniforms, Hot Wheels hall, Interactive Science exhibits, Interactive Space Scale & Flight Timeline, Robots, Airplanes

2007 Folk Art Family Festival Friday, July 20th, & Saturday, July 21st, at The Children's Museum



Sponsored by NYSCA (New York State Council on the Arts), the 2-day *FolkArt Family Festival* provides a fun-filled opportunity to learn about the rich diversity of local traditions during interactive demonstrations with different cultures. **Friday: 12:30noon to 3:30pm** - Native American demonstrations: shell & leather jewelry; leather clothing; glass bead frames/purses; beadwork & cornhusk dolls; wooden walking stick carving; pottery demonstration; lacrosse stick making. **Saturday: 10:30am to 3:30pm** - Irish, Latino, Ukrainian, and Native American folk art demonstrations include: moccasin making; cornhusk doll making; featherwork; needlework; wax egg decorating. In addition, there will be music and dance performed by members of Utica's Mohawk Valley Latino Association, and Utica area's Irish musicians & dancers (fiddlers, bagpipes, Irish drums, dance jigs, etc.) \$9.00 per person includes admission to all 4 floors (members free). Visitors will also be able to interact with the folk artists.
