Every Day: Space Exploration – During our 4th Floor opening times, learn about the story of human exploration of space through our NASA exhibits, including our Space Scale & interactive timeline!

Every Day: On our 1st floor, children 4 & under enjoy our life-size wooden train & interact with toys in Play Space, while children 5 & up enjoy Exploration Station with various 'stores' and 'businesses' that enhance learning.
