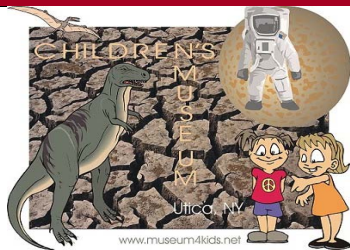

Dear Educator: As you plan your field trips, we wanted to remind you of the Curriculum Enrichment Activities - *meeting NYS Learning Standards in Arts, SS & MST* with our *100's of Interactive Exhibits in 60 Pavilions on 4 floors* – all close by to you, eliminating long bus rides! The Children's Museum considers it your aid in delivering quality education to your students.

We believe you'll find we complement your classroom topics by adding a memorable hands-on dimension to your students' learning experience, helping them improve their mandatory NYS test scores. You can take students through exhibits on your own with a visit schedule and activity sheet provided or you can book a visit & program with our skilled educators, which includes pre- & post-visit materials.

Our 1st floor features *Exploration Space*, with several "stores", including a *Microbiology Room*, a *Grocery Store*, a *Bank*, and a *NetSafety Room*. Also featured on this floor is our *PlaySpace* for Toddlers 3 years of age and younger, a life-size *Wooden Train* for children of all ages, and a *Hyperbolic Funnel*.

Our 2nd floor features our *Iroquois Longhouse* with interactive kiosks; *Paleontology/Fossil Dig* center & *Dinorama*; unique *History Diorama*; & *Erie Canal* exhibit's importance to NYS growth. Our *new LED PlayDance Floor* lets youngsters burn off pent up energy while demonstrating green energy.

Our 3rd floor *Living Science Center* features critters & insects, including our *Butterfly Farm & Active Beehive*. Also on this floor are our *Weather Room's* live weather station, our *Radio Room's* live radio station, our *History Wall's* cultural settlers, and our new History & Science *Touch Screen* Exhibits.

Our 4th floor houses our exciting *NASA exhibits* (*Mars Rover, Lunar Lander, and Shuttle*) plus an interactive *Space Scale*, a *History of Exploration* multimedia exhibit, *Airplanes*, & an *Astronomy Room*.

A visit to the Children's Museum is both educational and enjoyable, where children learn by doing! As NYS Senator Joe Griffo and NYS Assemblywoman RoAnn Desito said, "A vital community resource, *The Children's Museum is a tremendous educational asset for the area's youth*".

Plan on a 2 hour visit to take advantage of all we offer (or 3 hrs with a bag lunch & program).
