2010 Inductees

Bicycling — the late Russ Dahlin, introduced by Dick Jordan, class 2006

Russ began serious biking in the 1970's when the price of gasoline skyrocketed. He did recreational cycling weekends and biked to work. After retiring, he spent time cycling Grand Canyon, Arizona, Alaska, Canada, & Ride for Missing Children, inspiring many to continue biking into later years. His daughter, Heidi, accepts.

Bicycling — Larry Kolwaite, introduced by Jim White, class of 2008

Larry has been actively involved in local Special Olympics since the early 1980's, helping mentally disabled individuals participate. As cycling coach, Larry and an athlete were selected to attend the 2002 Special Olympics 3 Continent Games in Athens, Greece & 2003 Special Olympics World Summer Games in Dublin, Ireland.

Kayaking — Ben Stookesberry, introduced by Eric Jackson, class of 2006

Ben was the first kayaker to descend 70+ sections of rivers in 13 countries. A Class V expedition kayaker, he has been featured in a variety of media outlets, chosen National Geographic Explorer of the year in 2008, and has produced 8 feature-length kayak movies through his production company, Clear H2O Films.

Kayaking — Jim Schreiner, introduced by Tim Norray, class of 2004

Jim is a multiple times kayak medalist and competitor in the Empire State Games, National Championships, Pan American Championships, Pan American Games, World University Games, World Masters Games. He had the honor of carrying the US Flag at Opening Ceremonies of the 1991 Pan American Games in Havana Cuba.

Rowing — Bill Garrett, introduced by Dave Manore (nominator Ed W)

CEO of Boy Scouts of America Revolutionary Trails Council, Bill directs the organization's administration and Advises the Executive Board which serves over 2,000 adult volunteers, and 8,000 young men, awarding 1,000's of badges since 1938.

Canoeing — Pam Hyland, introducer Christina Verratti (nominated by Ed)

CEO of Girl Scouts of NYPENN Pathways, Inc., comprising five Girl Scout councils in 24 counties in upstate New York and 2 counties in Pennsylvania. The GSA have been training girls in Adventure Sports since 1912 & awarding badges since 1985.
