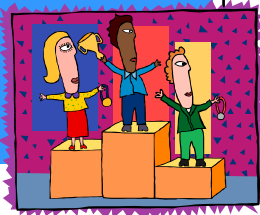

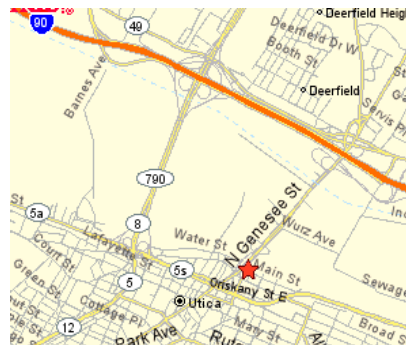

# Educational Field Trips



**Permanently Chartered by NYS Bd of Regents the Children's Museum Curriculum Enrichment Programs and Exhibits meet NYS Learning Standards in the Arts, SS, & MST. Maps, self-guided exhibit info, and follow-up visit materials provided.**

## **MST (Math, Science, Technology):**

**Music on the Move** Explore mathematical movement & rhythm in a fun way on our LED floor.

**The Science of Weather** Students learn forces of nature, weather, clouds in our weather room

**Rub-a-Dub-Dub** Static electricity is explored as students discover attraction & repulsion.

**Dance of the Honeybee** Children learn the role of a beehive's social structure.

**Going On a Bug Hunt** Students learn the importance of insects & bugs are to our world.

**Where they go in the Snow** Using animal skins & shells, learn adaptations of animals to survive winter.

**Space Exploration** Learn about 100 yrs of flight, why we explore space & interact w/NASA exhibits.

## **ARTS (Cultural Contributions):**

**Harvest Feast** With soft-sculpture food, children learn how 1st Thanksgiving was celebrated.

**Archeological Dig** Students go on a dig for artifacts, learning the proper scientific procedure.

**Dinosaurs & Fossils** Learn how scientists pieced together clues to understand Dinosaurs & extinctions.

**Clues to the Past:** Discover how archaeologists use rocks & fossils to learn about human cultures.

## **SS (Social Studies):**

**Erie Canal History** Covers beginnings of the Mohawk Valley & how the canal impacted life in NYS.

**Settlement Beginnings:** Discover objects traded in settlements & understand NYS history.

**History's in the Bag** Children analyze artifacts about early Central NY residents.

**Moccasins & Sneakers** Children compare/contrast their lives w/Iroquois who lived 100's of yrs ago,

**Visiting our Museum on individual/family rate:** General Admission to Museum... \$7.00 children; \$8.00 seniors; \$9.00 adults (3-17 years of age; members & children under 2 years of age Free)  
**Visiting our Museum for a Visit/Tour:** (*you can combine classes to reach reduced numbers*)  
\$6.75 per person in groups of 15-24 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)  
\$6.00 per person in groups of 25-49 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)  
\$5.50 per person in groups of 50-74 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)  
\$5.25 per person in groups of 75-99 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)  
\$5.00 per person in groups of 100 or more (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)  
(One teacher or adult chaperone is required for every six students, and will be admitted at no cost. Additional chaperones pay the visit rate).

\$7.00 per person in groups of 25-49 (visit & program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$6.25 per person in groups of 75-99 (visit & program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)
