VISITING OUR MUSEUM ON AN INDIVIDUAL/FAMILY RATE: General Admission to Museum... \$9.00 adults; \$8.00 seniors; \$7.00 children (3-17 years of age; members & children 2 & under are Free)

VISITING OUR MUSEUM FOR A VISIT: (you can combine classes to reach reduced numbers)

\$6.00 per person in groups of 15-24 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$5.75 per person in groups of 25-49 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$5.50 per person in groups of 50-74 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$5.25 per person in groups of 75-99 (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$5.00 per person in groups of 100 or more (visit only, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

(One teacher or adult chaperone is required for every six students, and will be admitted at no cost.

Additional chaperones pay the visit rate).

VISITING OUR MUSEUM WITH A PROGRAM FOR GROUP: (combine classes to reach reduced numbers)

\$7.00 per person in groups of 15-24 (visit & 20 minute program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$6.75 per person in groups of 25-49 (visit & 20 minute program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$6.50 per person in groups of 50-74 (visit & 20 minute program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$6.25 per person in groups of 75-99 (visit & 20 minute program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

\$6.00 per person in groups of 100+ (visit & program, 1 chaperone free for every 6 paid)

NOTE: A 48 hour notice must be given if you need to cancel a program. Otherwise a \$1.00 per child fee will apply

LUNCH AVAILABILITY: For safety reasons, food & beverages are not allowed on the floor or in our exhibit areas. Visitors may eat their bag lunches in our 1st floor Museum Kitchen/Bday Room.
